DIAGNOSIS

Emotionally Unstable Personality Disorder, Borderline Type (F60.31)
Recurrent Depressive Disorder (F33.x), Dissociative Disorder (F44.9), Recurrent Self-Injurious Behavior,
Multiple Low-Lethality Suicide Attempts,
Compulsive Sexual Behavior

CASE HISTORY

Initial: First signs of depressive symptoms following the onset of puberty
Day 90: Onset of self-injurious behavior (arms, thighs), Day 230: First suicide attempt (intentional medication overdose), Day 410: Increase in dissociative episodes
Current Status: Clinically unstable despite high-dose pharmacological treatment

INTERVENTIONS

- Daily supervised medication administration
- Weekly psychiatric evaluations
- Behavioral Therapy (frequently refused)
- Crisis intervention as required
- Continued public appearances despite ongoing symptom burden

OBSERVATIONS

- Frequent dissociative episodes
- Intense sexual relationship with Dwarf Eight
- Escalation of self-injurious behavior
- Suicidal ideation
- Treatment refusal
- Significant public-performance burden

TREATMENT PLAN

Close psychiatric monitoring, High-dose Lorazepam treatment,
Continuation of public appearances
Behavioral management of self-harm
Monitoring of relationship with Dwarf Eight

MEDICATION

Lorazepam (8 mg/day), Sertraline (SSRI, 150 mg/day), Trazodone (350 mg/day),
Haloperidol (10 mg) during acute psychiatric crises, Melatonin as needed
