PROJECT HAPPY ENDING (MEASURE 4b)

Date: August 4, 2001

OBJECTIVES:

- Ensure a consistently positive narrative experience throughout Blisswood.
- Negative emotional deviations, rebellious tendencies, and individual psychological dysfunctions are to be regarded as threats to the collective happiness economy.

FOUNDATIONAL PRINCIPLES:

- Happy fairy-tale figures embody the ideal: they function, perform, and do not question.
- Sadness is a symptom of insufficient system integration.
- Anyone unwilling to embrace a happy ending endangers the happy ending of everyone else.

STRATEGY:

- Early identification of potentially dysfunctional residents
- Psychometric screening within schools and healthcare institutions
- Internal classification as "Disorder Type B" (Voluntary Non-Compliance)

MEASURE 4b (PROJECT HAPPY ENDING):

- Complete removal of affected subjects from public visibility
- Transfer to Abandon for "restructuring"
- Staging of an alternative narrative (e.g., relocation, accidental death)

EXECUTIVE AUTHORITY:

Kraken is granted unrestricted access to all affected target groups and may act with the necessary degree of force, without prior judicial review, whenever a threat to the collective narrative has been identified.
